Guest Speaker

On February 4th, Valley Academy was privileged to host guest speaker and Holocaust survivor, Marion Weinzweig. Our students sat quietly as Mrs. Weinzweig told them her story of survival in the ghettoes of

Poland. Her story is unique in that she was born in the ghetto, escaped death with the help of nuns in a convent, and was found by her father five years later! Marion shocked her listeners when she explained how it took her 70 years to locate her birth certificate in Poland with the help of an investigator. An excellent classroom discussion took place afterwards, and later, students wrote "thank you" letters to Marion asking her some questions about her life. Overall, her visit left an enduring impact on our Class of 2016. All of us learned a powerful lesson about never taking our identities for granted again.
