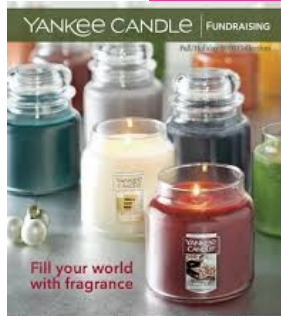
Coyote Pride and Staff Appreciation are also looking for help currently.
